Safety **First:**

To keep your Manfresh Pro Series performing at its best, give it a quick clean after every use — and replace the blade (cutter head) if it ever starts to lose sharpness.

QUICK REMINDERS:

- Read everything before using.
- Keep your straightener away from water always.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY:

Even when switched off, the straightener still carries electrical current.

TO STAY SAFE:

- Always unplug it immediately after use
- Never use near water or in the bath/shower
- Don't store it where it could fall into a sink or tub
- Don't place it in or near water or other liquids
- If it gets wet, unplug it right away and don't touch it

HEAT + FIRE SAFETY:

To avoid injury, burns, or fire:

- Never use the tool with a damaged cord.
- Never attempt to open or repair the appliance, there are no user-serviceable parts.
- Check the voltage matches your local mains supply.
- Don't leave it plugged in or unattended.
- Don't place items on the hot plates.
- Don't use near tubs, sinks, or anything filled with water.
- Don't place the plates against skin — they get hot!
- Always keep the cord away from heat.
- If the cord is damaged, contact us — don't risk it.
- Never use an extension cord with this product.
- Never use it with wet hands.
- Always unplug after use, especially in bathrooms.

FOR HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN:

- This tool isn't meant for young children or those who aren't confident using electrical devices.
- Kids should always be supervised around styling tools.
- Never let children play with the appliance.

CORD SAFETY:

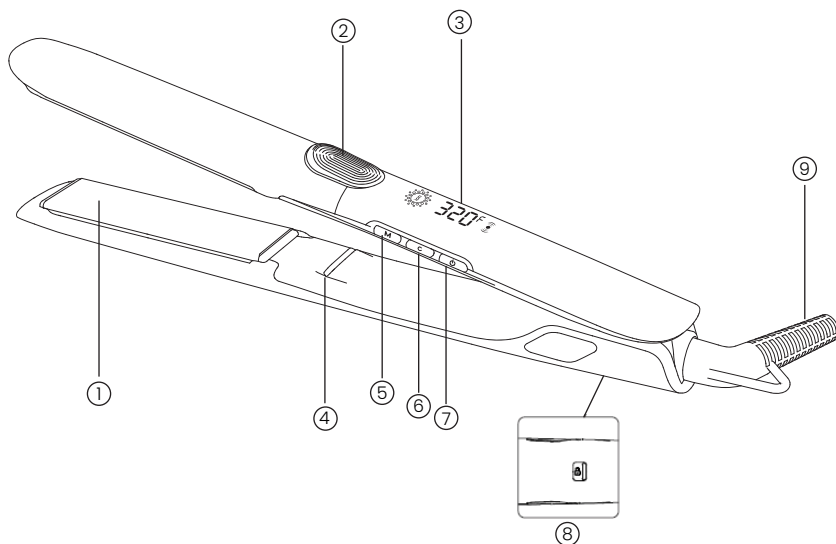
- Take care of your cord, it's essential to how your straightener performs.
- Never pull or yank on the cord or the plug.
- To plug in: hold the plug and insert it firmly.
- To unplug: grip the plug itself, not the cord.
- Before each use, check the cord for any damage, cuts, or wear.
- If you notice fraying or cracks, stop using it immediately and contact support.
- Don't wrap the cord tightly around the tool, that can cause damage.
- Never use the straightener if the cord is damaged, the device cuts in and out, or stops working entirely.

CONNECTING TO POWER:

- Make sure your wall voltage matches the voltage printed on your straightener.
- Unplug it when not in use.
- Keep it away from moisture and never operate it in the rain or near water.
- Stop using immediately if the cord is damaged.

Components:

MEET YOUR STRAVELLE PRO SERIES.



1. Heating Plate
2. Thumb Rest
3. Temperature Display
4. Negative Ion Outlet
5. **"M"** Button – Turns vibration on/off
6. **"C"** Button – Adjusts temperature
7. **"G"** Button – Powers ON/OFF
8. Lock-in Switch
9. Power Cord

Getting Started:

The Stravelle Pro Series is designed for styling human hair only.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- Towel-dry your hair after washing
- Gently detangle your hair, no hairspray, gels, or flammable products.
- Wrap a towel around your neck and shoulders for added protection.

How to Use:

1. Start with freshly washed, fully dry hair.
2. Double-check that your voltage matches your country's outlet.
3. Plug in the straightener and place it on a flat, heat-safe surface.
4. Press the **"Power"** (G) button to turn it on.
5. Use the **"C"** button to set your temperature. Choose between: 320°F, 340°F, 360°F, 380°F, 390°F, 410°F, 430°F, 450°F
6. The display will flash until it reaches your selected temperature.
7. Press the **"M"** Button to activate the Vibrating Plate Technology.
8. This helps reduce heat damage, glide more easily, and create sleeker results.
9. The device will automatically shut off after 60 minutes for safety.
10. After styling, press the **"G"** Button again to turn it off.
11. Once cooled, wipe the plates with a soft, dry cloth (no chemical cleaners).

STYLING: STRAIGHTENING:

1. For best results, hair should be clean and dry.
2. Start near the scalp and take a small section of hair (about 2 inches wide and ¼ inch deep). Clamp the section between the plates.
3. Gently glide from roots to ends in one smooth motion. Maintain light tension and avoid touching your scalp or hands with the hot plates.

Temperature Guide:

Hair Type	Temperature Setting (°C)
Fragile — Fine or chemically processed hair	160°C / 170°C
Fine — Easy-to-curl, normal hair	182°C / 193°C
Coarse — Thick or hard-to-curl hair	199°C / 210°C / 221°C
Pro Use Only	232°C

Start on the lowest heat that gets results. It's gentler on your hair and just as effective.

Care & Cleaning:

Your Stravelle Pro Series straightener is easy to maintain and doesn't require any servicing. If anything seems off, unplug it and let it cool completely before contacting support.

TO CLEAN:

- Switch it off and unplug it
- Let it cool fully on a heat-safe surface
- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth, no harsh cleaners, sprays, or chemicals

STORING YOUR STRAIGHTENER:

- Never wrap the cord tightly around the device
- Let it cool before putting it away
- Use the lock switch to keep the plates closed for neat storage
- Keep it in the heat-resistant pouch (if included) to protect your surfaces

ECO CONSIDERATIONS:

- When your straightener reaches the end of its life, don't throw it in household waste.
- Please dispose of it at an approved electronics recycling point.

DISPOSAL INFORMATION:



- This symbol means your product should be recycled, not binned.
- Bring it to your local collection site for electrical and electronic waste.
- Recycling properly helps protect the environment and human health.

GFCI

Safety Notice:



READ THIS. IT COULD SAVE A LIFE.

If you're using your straightener in the bathroom, make sure your outlet is protected by a GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter).

A GFCI is a special type of outlet that shuts off power instantly when it detects danger. It offers far better protection than a regular fuse or breaker.



The National Electrical Code requires GFCIs in all new bathrooms, garages, kitchens, and outdoor outlets.

Installing a GFCI: A licensed electrician can install one easily, or you can use a portable GFCI plug.
